## FEATURED RECIPE

### Crockpot Hot Chocolate

Prep Time: 5 Minutes  
Total Time: 2 Hours

Equipment: Crockpot

#### Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 Cups Chocolate Chips
- 1/4 Cup Cocoa Powder
- 1/4 Cups Powdered Sugar
- 14 Oz Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 Cups Heavy Cream
- 6 Cups Whole Milk
- 1 Tablespoon Vanilla Extract
- 2 Cups Mini Marshmallows

#### Directions:

1. Add the chocolate chips, cocoa powder, powdered sugar, sweetened condensed milk, heavy cream, milk, and vanilla to a large crock pot and whisk together.
2. Cook the mixture on low for 2 hours, stirring occasionally.
3. After the 2 hours is up, stir in the marshmallows and let sit for about 10 minutes and stir them again, they should completely dissolve.
4. Hot chocolate can be kept on warm all day. Store any left in the fridge for up to 5 days! Enjoy!
