FEATURED RECIPE

One Pot Mac and Cheese

Prep Time: 5 Minutes
Total Time: 30 Min

Equipment: Serving Dish

Ingredients:

- 3.5 Cups Whole milk
- 3 Cups Water
- 1 Package (16oz) Elbow Macaroni
- 4 Oz Velveeta, cubed
- 2 Cups Shredded Sharp Cheddar Cheese
- 1/2 Tsp Salt
- 1/2 Tsp Coarsely ground pepper

Directions:

1. In a Dutch oven, combine milk, water and macaroni; bring to a boil over medium heat.
2. Reduce heat and simmer until macaroni is tender and almost all the cooking liquid has been absorbed, 12-15 minutes, stirring frequently. Reduce heat to low; stir in cheeses until melted.
3. Season with salt and pepper.
